

# SUBJECTS

## LEVEL ONE

25 core subjects make up 300 total hours of class time over 20 months. Class names do change slightly from year to year.



### **25 Typical Subjects: Level 1**

#### **1-Aspects of Grace**

The meaning, usage and effects of the different aspects of the grace of God in the life of the individual & Includes a section on balance in fasting.

#### **2-Authority of the Believer - Part I**

What is authority? When and how do we obtain authority? What authority did we get from God and how do we exercise it? The Name of Jesus & a brief Introduction to Spiritual Warfare.

#### **3-Bibliology & Hermeneutics**

Helps the student to develop greater confidence in the integrity of the Bible. This is accomplished by examining proofs of the Bible's divine origin, the reliability of a translation, and the transmission of biblical manuscripts from the original copies to the present. Also, you will be introduced to different methods of bible study including a brief explanation of the most often used and widely accepted principles of Bible interpretation.

#### **4-Biblical Economics**

To understand our responsibility to steward our material wealth in line with God's purposes while recognising God's will regarding prosperity. The student learns the motivation as well as the responsibility of every believer in connection to finances.

#### **5-Church History & Charismatic Perspectives**

From the birth of the Church until present day, what are the most important events and people during different periods of Church History? Including an emphasis on the Church's history in Nigeria with a special emphasis on the last century with regard to the Pentecostal, Charismatic and Word of Faith Movements.

#### **6-Christ the Healer - Part 1**

A study of 25 reasons that healing is the will of God for today.

#### **7-Ecclesiology**

This course builds a deep understanding of God's emphasis on, and honour for, the Local Church and its central role in His plan for salvation for all mankind. We also look at church government in the New Testament, and introduce the 5-fold spiritual leadership offices.

#### **8-Eschatology**

Signs of the end times, the timely order of End-time events and their meaning for us as Christians.

#### **9-Faith Foundations**

What is faith? How does faith come? How do we activate faith? How do I use the shield of faith? What it means to 'live by faith' and what does the faith-life look like?

#### **10-Great Commission - Part 1**

An overview of why mankind is separate from God, a study of the reality of eternal separation and a showing forth of God's strategic plan for the salvation of all mankind and how we are to connect with it. There is also an introduction to personal evangelism and its different forms as found in the Bible.

### **11-Holy Spirit**

The person and divinity of the Holy Spirit and His work in the life of every believer, with special focus on the Baptism in the Spirit.

### **12-Introduction to Theology**

Building on what you learned in *Bibliology and Hermeneutics*, this class shows a practical application of how to 'correctly divide the Word of Truth' by looking at the foundational doctrines of the Spirit-filled, Word based Christian as well as discussing the Rhema Nigeria Statement of Faith.

### **13-Life of Honour**

A look from a biblical perspective at the God-ordained structure of authority - in the home and in the local and universal church.

### **14-Love of God**

The goal of this class is to show forth the revelation that God is Love, and how His display of love for man translates to a divine source of love that is in us and how to allow this divine love to rule and govern our every action. We also see how Love is the source of the Fruit of the Spirit and touch on each of the 9-fold Fruit.

### **15-Marriage, Family & Ministry**

Teaching about the practical and spiritual aspects of family and ministry life and showing the Biblical pattern for balancing the two.

### **16-New Testament Literature**

A general overview of the New Testament, including the content and purpose of each of the New Testament books.

### **17-Old Testament Literature**

A general overview of the message and historical events of the Old Testament, as well as a look at the lives of various Old Testament saints.

### **18-Paul's Theology of Righteousness**

A practical study of the subject of "righteousness by faith" verses "righteousness by works".

### **19-Pneumatology I (How to be led by the Holy Spirit)**

This class deals with the three-fold nature of man and how to be led by the Holy Spirit.

### **20-Pneumatology II (Manifestations of the Holy Spirit)**

Each of the nine Manifestations of the Spirit will be taught as to their specific operation, manifestation and distribution within the Body of Christ.

### **21-Practical Theology of Ministry**

We discuss the calling and separation into ministry with special focus on character development and qualifications for the ministry. We will also talk about your practical ministry requirement (PMR), discuss how to effectively lead a small group, & share practical keys to being effective in leading a prayer meeting or a time of worship which you will use in class.

### **22-Prayer Principles – Part I**

The purpose and importance of prayer, different kinds of prayer that are found in the Bible and being led by the Holy Spirit in prayer.

### **23-Principles of Spiritual Formation**

The necessity of spiritual growth as a foundation for being able to fulfil the will of God and how to establish disciplines that produce this growth in your personal relationship with God.

### **24-Redemptive Realities**

We discuss the standing we have with God through the redemptive work of Christ. ("In Him" Realities), and introduce the biblical importance of the blood covenant to create an awareness of its principles, application, and influence on our relationship with God.

### **25-Spiritual Leadership - Part 1**

Qualifications for spiritual leaders and their duties and responsibilities in the Body of Christ.
